

IDC Childcare **Wellness Guidelines**

Please do not bring your child to IDC childcare if any of the following exist:

- Less than 5 days have passed since the first symptoms of a cold or flu began and the child has not seen a doctor
- Fever (over 100.4 degrees) within the past 24 hours
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- Yellow or green runny nose
- Any symptom of childhood diseases such as scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chicken pox or whooping cough
- Common cold, including colored runny nose
- Sore throat
- Persistent Cough
- Any unexplained rash
- Any skin infection - boils, ringworm or impetigo
- Untreated pink eye or any other eye infection
- Any communicable disease
- Lice, including the presence of eggs or nits

If any of these symptoms are found present while your child is in childcare, you will be notified and asked to pick up your child. They may return to childcare when they have shown no symptoms for 24 hours prior to childcare.
