

Daily Health Screen for Covid-19 for anyone entering IDC Childcare facilities

Please do not come to IDC Childcare if you or your child have had Covid symptoms, been diagnosed with Covid-19, or been exposed to a person with Covid-19 within the past 5 days.*

**See question 3 for exceptions regarding vaccination status and primary exposure.*

Please perform the following screening on you and your children before entering IDC Childcare.

Have you or any of the children you are dropping off:

1. Been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 10 days?
2. Have you or any of the children you are dropping off had any of the following symptoms in the past 10 days?
 - Fever
 - Chills
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - New cough
 - New loss of taste or smell
3. Have you or any of the children you are dropping off: had close contact (been within 6 feet for a cumulative total of 15 minutes over a 24-hour period) with a person with undiagnosed symptoms of COVID-19 or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 10 days?
 - If yes but are fully vaccinated within the past six months (Pfizer or Moderna), the past two months (J&J) or are boosted: you may come, but please wear a mask for 10 days following exposure. Getting tested on day 5 after exposure is highly recommended.
4. Has any health department staff or a health care provider been in contact with the person you are dropping off and advised them to quarantine?

If you or your child answered yes to any of the above questions:

- You and your child will be permitted to return to childcare after 5 days of quarantine have been completed AND you/your child are not symptomatic. You must also wear a mask for 5 additional days.
- Ages 4 and under and unable to wear a mask: If your child is unable to wear a mask, please do not send them to IDC Childcare for a full 10 days following a positive test.
